But it is not the whole Quran.you should get a complete Quran with translation & explanation.

O ye who believe!

Spend out of (the bounties) we have provided for you, before the day comes when no bargaining (will avail), nor friendship nor intercession. Those who reject faith-they are the wrongdoers.

#### 08. Don't cancel your charity by citing or injury.

O ye who believe! Cancel not your charity by reminders of your generosity or by injury, - like those who spend their substance to be seen of men, but believe Neither in God nor in the last day.

They are in parable like a hard, barren rock, on which is a little soil: on it falls heavy rain, which leaves it (just) a bare stone.

They will be able to do nothing with aught they have earned. and God guideth not those who reject faith.

(S-II-BAQARA-264)

## 09. Spend in charity the good things from your wealth.

O ye who believe! Give of the good things which ye have (honourably) earned, and of the fruits of the earth which We have produced for you, and do not even aim at getting anything which is bad, in order that out of it ye may give away something, when ye yourselves would not receive it except with closed eyes. And know that God is free of all wants, and worthy of all praise. (S-II-BAQARA-267)

#### 10. Give up usury.

O ye who believe! Fear God, and give up what remains of your demand for usury, if ye are indeed believers.

## 11. Write down & get witness in transactions.

O ye who believe! When ye deal with each other, in transactions involving future obligations in a fixed period of time, reduce them to writing. Let a scribe write down faithfully as between the parties: let not the scribe

taught him, so let him write. let him who incurs The liability dictate, but let him fear his Lord God, and not diminish aught of what he owes. If the party liable is mentally deficient, or weak, or unable himself to dictate, let his guardian dictate faithfully. And get two witnesses, out of your own men, and if there are not two men, then a man and two women, such as ye choose, for witnesses. So that if one of them errs, the other can remind her. The witnesses should not refuse when they are called on (for evidence). Disdain not to reduce to writing (your contract) for a future period, whether it be small or big: it is juster in the sight of God, more suitable as evidence, and more convenient to prevent doubts among yourselves but if it be a transaction which ye carry out on the spot among yourselves,

refuse to write: as God has

reduce it not to writing. But take witnesses whenever ye make A commercial contract; and let neither scribe nor witness suffer harm.

If ye do (such harm),

It would be wickedness in you.

So fear God;

for it is God that teaches you.

And God is well acquainted with all things.

O ye who believe! If ye listen to a faction among the People of the Book, they would (indeed) render you apostates After ye have believed! (S-III -AL-I-IMRAN-100)

O ye who believe! Fear God as He should be feared, and die not except in a state of Islam. (S-III –AL-I-IMRAN- 102)

### 14. Take into your intimacy only believers.

O ye who believe! Take not into your intimacy Those outside your ranks: They will not fail to corrupt you. They only desire your ruin: rank hatred has already appeared from their mouths: what their hearts conceal is far worse.

We have made plain to you the Signs, If ye have wisdom. (S-III –AL-I- IMRAN- 118)

#### 15. Devour not usury.

O ye who believe! Devour not usury, doubled & multiplied; but fear God; that ye may (really) prosper. (S-III-AL-I-IMRAN-130)

## 16. Don't obey the unbelievers.

O ye who believe!
If ye obey the unbelievers, they will drive you back on your heels,
And ye will turn back (from faith)
to your own loss.
(S-III-AL-I-IMRAN-149)

#### 17. Don't talk like the unbelievers.

O ye who believe! Be not like the unbelievers, who say of their brethren, when they are travelling through the earth or engaged in fighting: "If they had stayed with us, they would not have died, or been slain." This that God may make it a cause of sighs and regrets in their heats. It is God that gives Life & Death, and God sees well all that ye do. (*S-III-AL-I-IMRAN-156*)

## 18. Persevere in patience & constancy.

O ye who believe! Persevere in patience & constancy; vie in such perseverance; Strengthen each other; And fear God; that ye may prosper. (S-III-AL-I-IMRAN-200)

## 19. Treat widows & wives with kindness & equity.

O ye who believe! Ye are forbidden to inherit women against their will. Nor should ye treat them with harshness. that ye may take away part of the dower

ye have given them,-except where they have been guilty of open lewdness: on the contrary live with them on a footing of kindness & equity. If ye take a dislike to them It may be that ye dislike a thing, and God brings about through it a great deal of good.

But when ye are clear of the Sacred Precincts & of pilgrim garb, ye may hunt and let not the hatred of some people in (once) shutting you out of the Sacred Mosque lead you to transgression (and hostality on your part). Help ye one another in righteousness & piety, but help ye not one another in sin & rancour: Fear God: for God is strict in punishment. (S-V-MAIDA-03)

## 30. Get purified by 'Wudhu', bathe or 'Tayammum'.

O ye who believe! When you prepare for prayer, wash your faces,

And your hands (and arms) to the elbows: rub your heads (with water); & wash your feet to the ankles. If ye are in a state of ceremonial impurity, bathe your whole body. But if ye are ill, or on a journey, or one of you cometh from offices of nature, or ve have been in contact with women, and ye find no water, then take for yourselves clean sand or earth, & rub therewith your faces & hands. God doth not wish to place you in a difficulty, But to make you clean, & to complete His favour to you, that ye may be grateful. (S-V- MAIDA-07)

That is the grace of God, which He will bestow on whom He pleaseth. And God encompasseth all, and He knoweth all things.

## 39. Don't prey on in pilgrim garb

O ye who believe
God doth but make a trial of you
in a little matter of game well
with in reach of your hand & of
your lances, that he may test

## 40. If prey on then pay penalty

O ye who believe

O ye who believe! Betray not the trust of God & the Apostle. Nor misappropriate knowingly things entrusted to you.

If ye fear God, he will grant you a criterion (to judge between right & wrong), remove from you (all) evil (that may afflict) you, and forgive you: for God is the Lord of grace unbounded.

O ye who believe! Fight the Unbelievers who gird you about, and let them find firmness in you: and know that God is with those who fear him. (S-IX-TAUBA-123)

## 56. Adore your lord & do good.

O ye who believe! Bow down, prostrate yourselves, and adore your lord; and do good; that ye may prosper.

## 57. Don't follow Satan's footsteps.

O ve who believe! Follow not Satan's footsteps: if any will follow the footsteps of Satan, he will but command what is shameful & wrong: and were it not for the grace & mercy of God on you, not one of you would ever have been pure: but God doth purify whom he pleases: and God is one who hears & knows (all things).

#### 58. Don't enter other's house without permission.

O ye who believe! Enter not houses other than your own, untill. ye have asked permission & saluted those in them: that is best for you, in order that ye may heed (what is seemly).

O ye who believe! Let those whom your right hands posses, and the (children) among you who have not come of age ask your permission (before they come to your presence), on three occasions: before morning prayer: the while ye doff your clothes for the noon day heat; and after the late-night prayer: these are your three times of undress: outside those times it is not wrong for you or for them to move about attending to each other: thus does God make clear the signs to you:

for God is full of knowledge &

wisdom.

O ye my servants who believe! Truly, specious is My earth: therefore serve ye me – (and me alone)!

O ye who believe! Celebrate the praises of God, and do this often.

## 63. Set the divorced women free in a handsome manner

O ye who believe! When ye marry believing women, and then divorce them before ye have touched them, no period of 'Iddat' have ye to count in respect of them: So give them a present & set them free
In a handsome manner.

## 64. Follow social norms & law of "Hijaab"

O ve who believe! Enter not the Prophet's houses,until leave is given you,-for a meal, (and then) not (so early as) to wait for its preparation: but when ye are invited, enter; And when ye have taken your meal, disperse, Without seeking familiar talk. Such (behavior) annoys the Prophet: he is ashamed to dismiss you, but God is not ashamed (to tell you the truth). And when ye ask (his ladies) for anything ve want, ask them from before a screen: that makes for better purity for your hearts & for theirs. Nor is it right for you that ye should annoy God's Apostle, or that ye should marry his widows after him at any time. Truly such a thing is in God's sight an enormity.

Those who patiently persevere will truly receive a reward without measure!"

#### 73. Take decision after ascertaining the truth.

O ye who believe! If a wicked person comes to you with any news, ascertain the truth, lest ye harm the people unwittingly and afterwards become full of repentance for what ye have done.

## 74. Don't laugh at others nor defame.

O ye who believe! Let not some men among you laugh at others: it may be that the (latter) are better than the (former): nor let some women laugh at others: it may be That the (latter) are better than the (former): nor defame nor be sarcastic to each other, nor call each other by (offensive) nicknames: ill-seeming is a name connoting wickedness, (to be used of one) after he has believed: and those who do not desist are (indeed) doing wrong. (S-XLIX-HUJRAT-11)

#### 75. Don't backbite & avoid suspicion.

O ye who believe! Avoid suspicion as much (as possible): for suspicion in some cases is a sin: and spy not on each other, nor speak ill of each other behind their backs. Would any of you like to eat the flesh of his dead brother? Nay, ye would abhor it ..... But fear God: for God is oft-returning, most Merciful. (S-XLIX-HUJRAT-12)

## 76. Believe in Allah & His Apostle earnestly to get light.

O ye who believe!
Fear God, and believe in his
Apostle, and He will bestow on
you a double portion of His
Mercy: He will provide for you
a light by which ye shall walk
(straight in your path), and He
will forgive you (your past): for
God is Oft-Forgiving Most
Merciful.

## 77. Don't hold secret counsel for iniquity but do it for righteousness.

O ye who believe! When ye hold secret counsel, do it not for iniquity and hostility, and disobedience to the Prophet; but do it for righteousness and self-restraint; and fear God, to whom ye shall be brought back.

## 79. Spending in charity is conducive to purity.

O ye who believe! When ye consult the apostle in private, spend something in charity before your private consultation. That will be best for you, and most conducive to purity (of conduct). But if ye find not (the wherewithal), God is oft forgiving, Most Merciful. (S-LVIII-MUJADILA-12)

#### 80. Think what ye have sent forth for the morrow.

O ye who believe!
Fear God, and let every soul look to what (provision) he has sent forth for the morrow.
Yea, fear God: for God is well-acquainted with (all) that ye do.

(S-LIX-HASHR-18)

## 81. Don't work in favour of unbelievers.

O ye who believe! Take not My enemies and yours as friends (or protectors),offering them (your) love, even though they have rejected the truth that has come to you, and have (on the contrary) driven out the Prophet and yourselves (from your homes), (simply) because ye believe in God your Lord! If ye have come out to strive in My way and to seek My good pleasure, (take them not as friends), holding secret converse of love (and friendship) with them: for I know full well all that ye conceal and all that ye reveal.

And any of you that do this has strayed from the straight path. (*S-LX-MUMTAHANA-01*)

#### 82. No marriage between Believer & Unbeliever

O ye who believe! When there come to you Believing women refugees, Examine (and test) them: God knows best as to their faith: if ye ascertain that they are Believers, then send them not back to the Unbelievers. They are not lawful (wives) for the Unbelievers, nor are the (Unbelievers) lawful (husbands) for them. But pay the unbelievers what they have spent (on their dower). And there will be no blame on you if ye marry them on payment of their dower to them. But hold not to the guardianship of Unbelieving women: ask for what ye have spent on their dowers and let the (Unbelievers) ask for what they have spent (on the dowers of women who come over to you). Such is the command of God: He judges (with justice) between you. And God is full of knowledge and wisdom. (S-LX-MUMTAHANA-10)

#### 83.Do not turn for friendship to the cursed people.

O ye who believe! Turn not (for friendship) to people on whom is the wrath of God. Of the hereafter they are already in despair, just as the Unbelievers are in despair about those (burried) in graves. (S-LX-MUMTAHANA-13)

#### 84. Don't say that what ye do not.

O ye who believe! Why say ye that which ye do not?

(S-LXI-SAFF-02)

## 85. Go for a bargain which will save you from a grievous penalty.

O ye who believe! Shall I lead you to a bargain that will save you from a grievous penalty?

(S-LXI-SAFF-10)

## 86. Be ye helpers of God: you will prevail.

O ye who believe!
Be ye helpers of God:
As said Jesus the son of Mary to the disciples,
"who will be my helpers to (the work of) God?"
Said the disciples, "we are
God's helpers!" Then a portion

of the children of Israel believed, and a portion disbelieved: but we gave power to those who believed, against their enemies, and they became the ones that prevailed.

(S-LXI-SAFF-14)

## 87. When there is call for prayer leave off business.

O ye who believe! When the call is proclaimed to prayer on Friday (the day of assembly), hasten earnestly to the remembrance of God, and leave off business (and traffic): that is best for you if ye but knew!

(S-LXII-JUMU'A-09)

## 88. Let not your riches or your children divert you from the remembrance of God.

O ye who believe! Let not your riches or your children divert you from the remembrance of God. If any act thus, the loss is their own. (S-LXIII-UNAFIQUN-09)

### 89. Be careful about your wives & children.

O ye who believe! Truly among your wives and your children are (some that are) enemies to yourselves: so beware of them! But if ye forgive and overlook, and coverup (their faults), verily God is oft forgiving, Most Merciful.

(S-LXIV-TAGABUN-14)

## 90. Save yourselves & your families from hell.

O ye who believe! Save yourselves and your families from a fire whose fuel is men and stones, over which are (appointed) Angels stern & severe, who flinch not (from executing) the commands they receive from God, but do (precisely) what they are commanded.

(S-LXVI-TAHRIM-06)

## 91. Turn to Allah with sincere repentance.

Turn to God with sincere repentance:
In the hope that your Lord will remove from you your ills and admit you to gardens beneath which rivers flow, - the day that God will not permit to be humiliated the Prophet & those who believe with him.
Their light will run forward before them and by their right

O ye who believe!

hands, while they say, "our Lord! perfect our light for us, and grant us forgiveness: for Thou hast power over all things."
